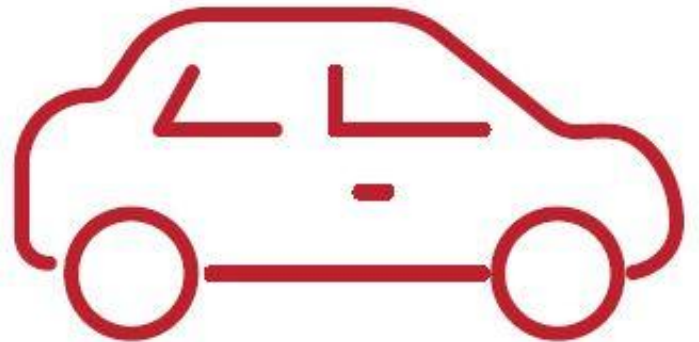
1. COMPULSORY THIRD PARTY (CTP)

Covers you for the cost of personal injuries only.

Buying 'CTP' differs from state to state e.g. in Victoria it's part of your registration, in NSW you need to buy a separate 'green slip'. This is the minimum insurance that you must buy. Check with the relevant authority in your state or territory to ensure you're covered.

2. THIRD PARTY

Covers you for damage you cause to other people's cars.



3. COMPREHENSIVE

Covers you for damage to your car AND other people's cars.

"But what happens if I don't have insurance?"

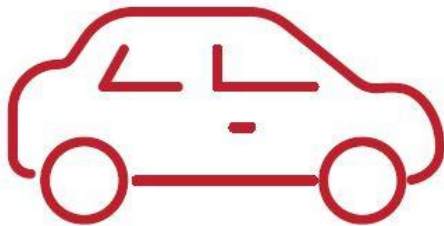
Note: Car insurance types and inclusions vary between states and territories. The above is a handy summary of the main differences.
